

OLWC Stewardship Committee Description

The OLWC Stewardship Committee, composed of Stewardship Coordinators, collaborates and cooperates on ongoing habitat restoration projects.

The Stewardship Committee meets once a month except in August and December
All Stewardship Coordinators whose site is in the Active Phase are required to attend
Stewardship Coordinators whose site is in the Transition or Long Term Phases are welcome to attend the meetings but are required to attend once a year to report on their site

The committee roles include a chair and a secretary.

The chair puts a meeting agenda together including suggestions from Stewardship Coordinators and sends the agenda to the members about one week before the meeting and posts it in the Stewardship folder in Google Drive.

The secretary takes meeting minutes and sends them to members and posts them in the Stewardship Committee folder.

Ad Hoc Committees can be formed from time to time as needed.

Some of the Stewardship Committee work includes but is not limited to:

- Discussing/Visiting Proposed Sites
- Collaborating on Site Projects
- Sharing challenges and solutions
- Submitting agenda items to the chair
- Annually presenting their site(s) to the OLWC Board
- Learning about Best Management Practices
- Learning about Annual Work Plans and Photo Point responsibilities
- Attending safety training events
- Attending training events
